Abstract: In applied ethics, several cases are called “marginal cases of morality,” such as whether we should eat meat. Scholars in animal ethics use different moral theories to argue whether it is morally wrong to eat meat. In this presentation, I am going to discuss the strengths and weaknesses of some approaches to animal ethics, and possible development of animal ethics in the future.
